Happening Tomorrow: City Hall Gallery Features Julia Clouten Show

The Springfield Arts Commission is pleased to present an exhibition of work by photographer Julia Clouten. The show will run from November 1-30 with an opening reception from 4-6 p.m., tomorrow, Nov. 9.

Clouten, a nature and portrait photographer based in Clackamas, Ore., will be showing a collection of macro photography taken throughout the Oregon coast, the Columbia River Gorge, and Maui, Hawaii. These images are arranged by seasons and concentrate on color and perspective.

Clouten will be available to discuss her work at the reception, which is open to the community. The reception will also feature light refreshments and live jazz by the Nathan Adams Quartet. Located on a ninety-foot wall just outside the entrance to the Springfield Library, City Hall Gallery is seen by approximately 3,700 visitors each month. Since 1989, the gallery has featured monthly shows by regional artists chosen by the Springfield Arts Commission. The Commission issues a call to artists each year.
