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Wheels by the Willamette Event

The City of Springfield, in partnership with Point2Point at Lane Transit District, will host Wheels by the Willamette from 4 to 6 p.m. on Friday, May 18, on the Northbank Path at Aspen and W D Street in Springfield. Wheels by the Willamette promotes walking and biking as healthy transportation options.

The event will feature free bicycle safety checks provided by Hutch's Bicycles, bicycle and pedestrian materials (i.e. bike maps, reflectors, etc.), snacks, and refreshments to support and appreciate people walking and riding in our community. Refreshments will include "bike blended smoothies" courtesy of Springfield Safe Routes to Schools.
