At its February 19, 2015 meeting, the Community Development Advisory Committee (CDAC) prioritized the Draft 2015 Consolidated Plan goals to guide the project selection of the \$124,737 that will be made available for sub-recipient projects through Springfield's Spring 2015 CDBG Request for Proposals (RFP). Project selection priority will be as follows:

1. Rehabilitate existing housing stock affordable to low-income persons (CDBG-eligible activity: rehabilitation).
2. Support a human service delivery system to address the needs of homeless persons and special needs populations (CDBG-eligible activity: public facilities and improvements).
3. Promote economic development and employment opportunities through the creation of jobs and business development (CDBG-eligible activity: microenterprise assistance, special economic development activities).
4. Increase the supply of affordable housing (CDBG-eligible activity: land acquisition, clearance of toxic chemicals, site improvements on publicly-owned land).
