Do I need special authorization to discharge from temporary groundwater clean-up or other sources into the sanitary sewer?

All parties desiring to temporarily discharge wastewater into the City's sanitary sewer system from groundwater clean-up or other sources must complete and submit a City of Springfield Application to Dispose of Contaminated Groundwater, submit the completed application to the City and receive an official letter of authorization prior to discharge.

The purpose of the application process is to determine if the discharge is allowable under Springfield Municipal Code: <http://municipalcodes.lexisnexis.com/codes/springfield/>.

The application is designed to allow City Staff to identify volume for billing and system capacity, general characteristics and potential hazardous nature of the proposed discharge.
