APPLICANTS SOUGHT FOR DOWNTOWN PARKING ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The City of Springfield is seeking applicants to form the Downtown Parking Advisory Committee (PAC). The PAC will be a volunteer body which advises the Springfield City Council, Springfield Economic Development Agency, and City staff on parking enforcement policy and program implementation in downtown Springfield.

Applicants must be one or more of the following: City residents or property owners, business owners, or an officer, partner, or employee of a business located in the downtown area.

At this time, the PAC is expected to meet once a month through 2014 and then once quarterly thereafter with terms of one and two years.

The **deadline to apply is 5 p.m. Friday, March 14, 2014**. Application forms are available in the Springfield City Manager's Office at City Hall, 225 Fifth Street, Springfield, OR. The City Council will complete interviews of eligible applicants during their Council Work Session, 5:30 p.m. Monday, March 24, 2014.
