CALL-TO-ARTISTS FOR JULY COMMUNITY ART SHOW

Exhibit will be in July 2014 in the Springfield City Hall Gallery

The Springfield Arts Commission seeks adult submissions for a summer show to be held in the City Hall Gallery in July 2014 with the theme, "*Branches: Splitting Off.*" Located outside the Springfield Public Library, a minimum of 500 people see the City Hall Gallery each day. Artists are encouraged to explore all aspects of the theme "*Branches: Splitting Off.*"

Artists need not be residents of Springfield. Artists are invited to submit a maximum of two pieces. There is space for two- and three-dimensional work, although there are some size requirements. All work must arrive dry and ready to hang or display in cases. All work must adhere to the gallery's guidelines. Sales are encouraged, although artists may display work that is not for sale. Each artist will be responsible for his or her own sales. There is no commission on sales or entry fees.
