Kutsinhira Marimba Youth Ensemble will entertain during this free program for children

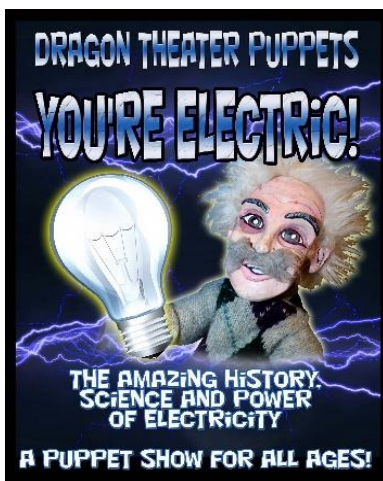
