A reception will be held on Friday, November 14, 2014 as part of Springfield's Downtown Art Walk

November's City Hall Gallery highlights the work of artist Cork Larsen.

Mr. Larsen's exhibit will showcase his decorative wild bird carvings as well as his acrylic landscapes and wildlife scenes.

The Springfield Arts Commission will host a reception at the City Hall Gallery as part of Springfield's Second Friday Downtown Art Walk on Friday, November 14, 2014 from 5-7 pm. Stop by to meet the artist; light refreshments will be offered.

At the reception, live music will be performed by the *Bellafina Ensemble*. The *Bellafina Ensemble* plays a mixture of classical, semi-classical, baroque, Renaissance and Celtic music, interspersed with themes from musicals, romantic ballads, waltzes, hymns, and popular standards. At a typical performance, expect to hear selections such as "All Things Bright and Beautiful," "Meditation," "Trumpet Voluntary," "Eleanor Rigby," "Danny Boy," "Make You Feel My Love," and "Garry O'Neill."

In its traditional configuration as a string quartet, the *Bellafina Ensemble* is comprised of two violins, viola, and cello, but they frequently perform in other combinations, such as a violin/cello duet, Celtic harp /violin duo, and a violin trio.

Regular gallery hours are: Monday and Tuesday, 8am-8pm; Wednesday and Thursday, 8am-6pm; Friday, 8am-5pm; Saturday, 10am-5pm; Sundays, closed.
