APPLICANTS SOUGHT FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Applications are being accepted for three vacancies on the city's Community Development Advisory Committee. The deadline to apply is **5 p.m. Friday, November 9, 2007**. Application forms are available in the City Manager's Office at City Hall, 225 Fifth Street. The City Council is scheduled to review applications at a meeting in late November or early December. Applications are encouraged from lower-income earners, residents of lower-income neighborhoods, racial and ethnic minorities, senior citizens, persons with disabilities, and female heads of households. Applicants must be residents of the City of Springfield, or reside within its Urban Growth Boundary.

Background:

These vacancies are due to term expirations of Bonnie Peterson, Dan Egan and Roxie Cuellar. The positions are at-large appointments. The terms for the three available positions will begin upon appointment by the Springfield City Council and will continue through December 31, 2011. The volunteer committee advises the City Council on all matters related to the City's housing and community development activities which are funded annually by a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and a HOME Investment Partnerships Program grant (HOME) from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. Projects funded through CDBG and HOME are to serve primarily low and moderate-income residents of the City.
