# **POLICY**

Ι

Persons acting in capacity as supervisors have the responsibility and authority of the supervisory position they are filling.

II

Consistent with laws, policies and ordinances, supervisors have authority to direct subordinate members to accomplish those tasks for which they are responsible.

III

Supervisory personnel are accountable for the performance of employees under their immediate direction.

IV

Members shall obey any lawful order of a supervisor, including any order relayed from a supervisor by an employee of the same or lesser rank.

 $\mathbf{V}$ 

When a member receives a conflicting order or directive, the member shall: inform the supervisor (or other person issuing the order) and ask for resolution of the conflict. In the absence of a satisfactory resolution, the member shall follow the most recent order.
