- ✓ Knowledge of state statutes, local ordinances, and department policies.
- ✓ Knowledge of the principles, practices, and techniques of law enforcement
- ✓ Knowledge of tactical operations
- ✓ Skilled in the use of firearms
- ✓ Ability to take reasonable action in emergency situations
- ✓ Ability to follow oral and written instructions
- ✓ Ability to persuade others in confrontations
- ✓ Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with others
- ✓ Ability to take orders during a tactical situation.
- ✓ Available for call-outs and specialized training assigned.
- ✓ Ability to obtain and maintain the physical standards set by the SWAT Team commander.
- ✓ Non-probationary employee (new hire)
- ✓ Has not received excessive sustained complaints.
