GENERAL ORDER 61.3.7

Driver Re-Examination

GENERAL ORDER CROSS-REFERENCE: None.

SUMMARY

Establishes procedures for the identification and referral of drivers recommended for reexamination by the Oregon Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV).

DISCUSSION

ORS 807.340 establishes that the Oregon DMV may require any licensed driver to appear before the Division and re-establish the person's eligibility. Eligibility is re-established by re-examination under ORS 807.070 or other procedures described in ORS 807.090, when the Division has reason to believe the driver:

- 1. No longer qualified to hold a license, driver permit or endorsement; or
- 2. No longer able to safely operate a motor vehicle.

POLICY

I

The Springfield Police Department shall request a driver re-examination upon discovering that any of the following conditions are suspected:

- 1. A person has a problem condition involving alcohol or controlled substances, which interferes with or seriously limits his driving abilities.
- 2. A person has physical or mental disabilities or disease which prevents the person from exercising reasonable and ordinary control over a motor vehicle while operating it upon the highways.
- 3. A person displays incompetency in operating a motor vehicle through his inability to understand highway signs that warn, regulate, or direct traffic and/or through his inability to maintain proper control of his vehicle.
