



Linda Lane Update

February 27, 2023

Springfield's City Council will consider action regarding the conservation easement for the property adjacent to Linda Lane on Monday, March 6, 2023, during the 7 p.m. regular session of the City Council Meeting. This action is being requested to provide permanent environmental protection for a portion of the wetlands located on the property.

Specifically during this meeting, Council will consider approval to authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute a deed restriction on City-owned property (Tax Lot 18-02-04-00-01511, aka "Linda Lane Property") located in southeast Springfield for the purpose of protecting wetlands on a portion of the property as mitigation for the [Jasper Trunk Sanitary Sewer Extension Phase 3 Project](#) (P21065).

Wetland mitigation is needed as part of the Jasper Trunk Sanitary Sewer Extension Phase 3 Project per state and federal permit regulations. The City Council Agenda packet for the March 6, 2023, meeting will be published later this week and we will send another email with a link to the packet then.

The action being requested this coming Monday, March 6 is not related to the possible annexation of the property adjacent to Linda Lane. When the topic of annexation of the property adjacent to Linda Lane has been scheduled to go before the City Council, we will send another update with related details include time and date.
