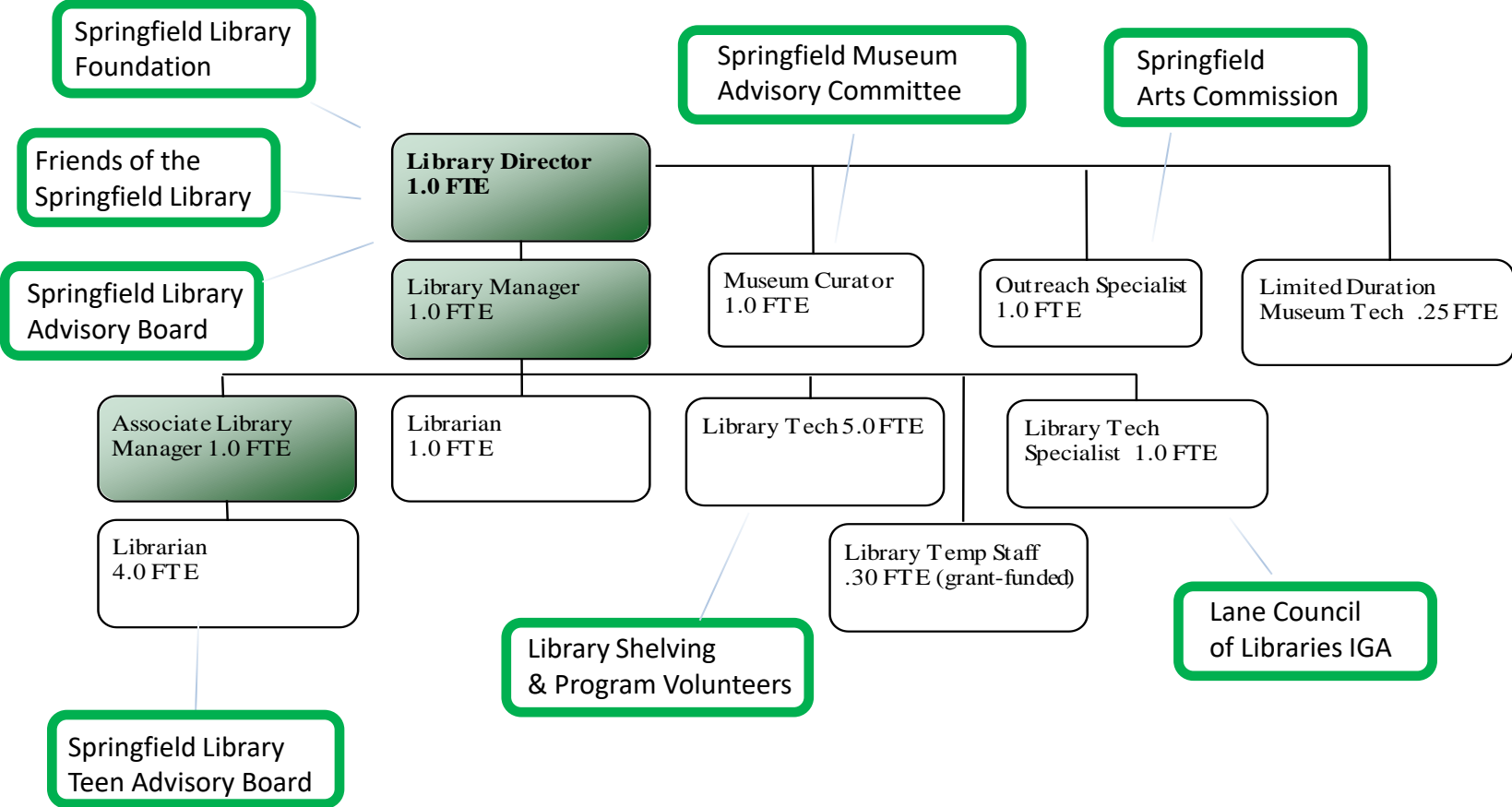

Library Organization Chart

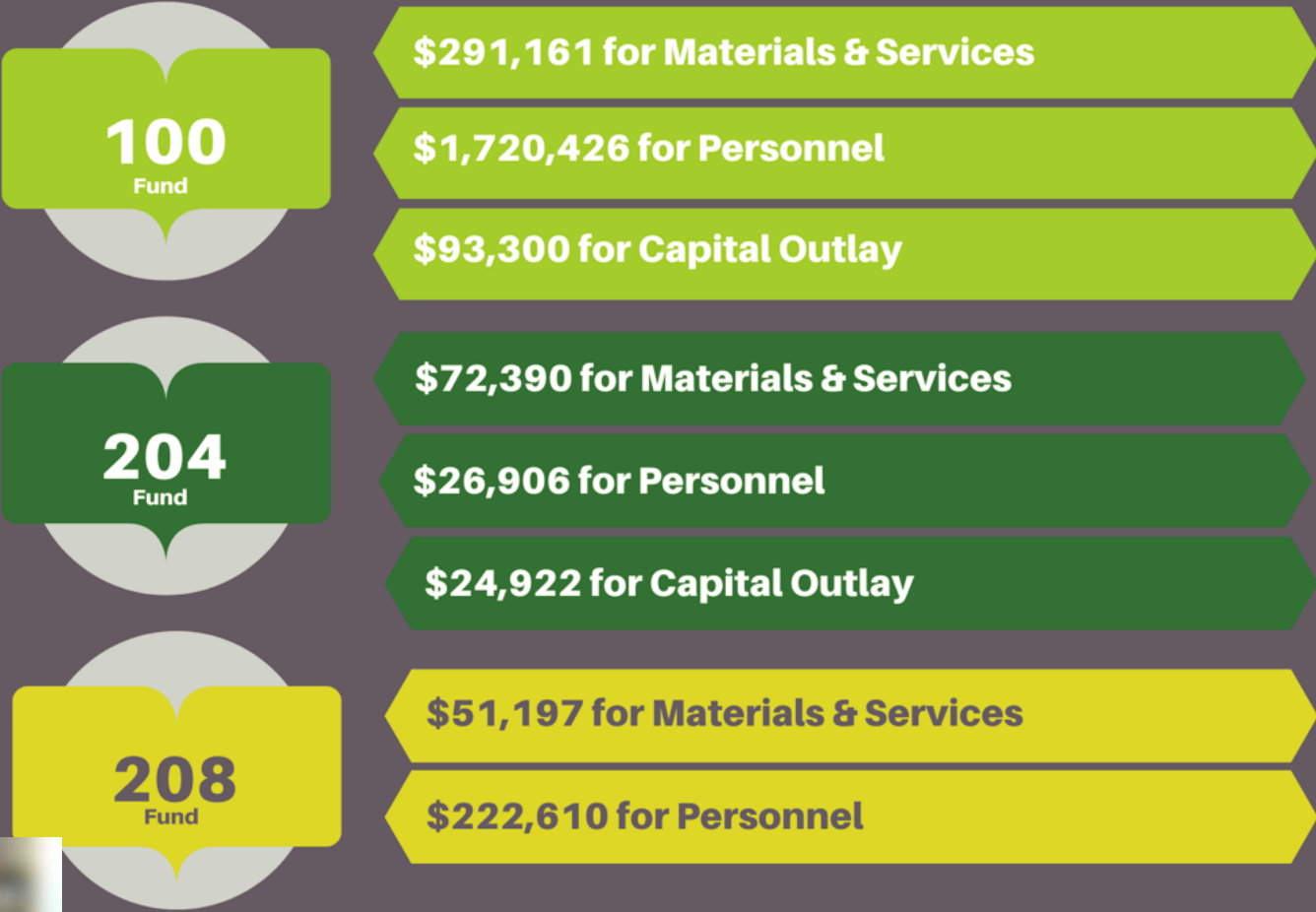




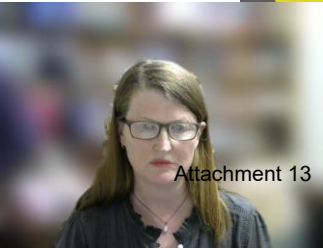

FY24 Proposed Library Budget



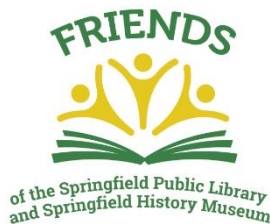
The library also proposes \$8,000 in spending from the 713 Fund for computer replacements.



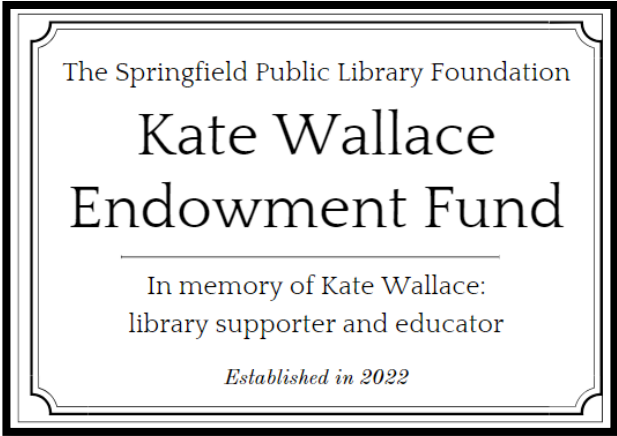
