UTILITY ACTIVITIES IN THE SPRINGFIELD CITY LIMITS

The City of Springfield, under Municipal Code 4.602, requires any utility who desires to provide service to persons in the City or to persons or areas outside the City using facilities located in the City apply for and be granted a Utility License. Carriers who utilize facilities of another licensed carrier for the distribution of their services shall be required to have a separate license. **PURPOSE**

The purpose of the license is to:

1) provide the City with accurate and current information concerning the utilities who offer utility services within the City, or that own or operate utility facilities within the City;

- 2) assist the City in enforcement of this Chapter;
- 3) assist the City in the collection and enforcement of any municipal taxes, franchise fees, license, permit or other fees or charges that may be due the City;

4) assist the City in monitoring compliance with local, and, to the extent authorized by law, with State and Federal laws.

FEE FOR USE OF PUBLIC WAYS/TAX FOR PROVIDING UTILITY SERVICE

There is an compensation fee for the Use of Public Ways OR a Tax for providing Utility Services. The fee or tax is paid quarterly, on or before the 45th day following the end of the calendar quarter.

Compensation Fee for Use of Public Ways/Tax for Providing Utility Service:

An annual fee of \$4.00 per foot of facility in the Right of Way or an annual tax of 5% of gross revenue.

Definition of annual fee (\$4.00 per foot)(SMC 4.706)

All persons not parties to a franchise or public way use agreement and occupying the public ways for placement of utility facilities but not providing utility service within the city shall pay a fee, in an amount fixed by resolution of the council for each foot or portion thereof occupied, subject to limitations in other state or federal laws.

Definition of annual tax (5% of gross revenue) (SMC 4.707)

All persons providing utility services in the city shall pay to the City of Springfield a utility tax in the amount of five percent of gross revenues, as herein defined, subject to limitations in other state or federal laws.
