What is happening?

The gravel portion, of S. 28th Street between S. F Street and the city limits, (approximately .25 miles), will be paved in the coming months.

When will the work happen?

The contractor hired for the project has started preliminary work including staging of equipment and placing erosion control. The project should be in full swing by the spring and must be completed by December 31, 2024.

Why do the project?

The purpose of this project is to pave the gravel section of the street to eliminate dust and rocks that are kicked up from vehicle traffic. In addition, the project will include new stormwater drainage features to manage the flow of stormwater and improve stormwater quality.

How will this affect me?

Once construction begins local access will be available to area businesses and residents, but at times you may experience delays. You may notice nuisance noise, dust, and heavy construction equipment during this time.
