- TVs
- Appliances
- Scrap lumber
- Scrap metal
- Computers
- Electronics
- Plastics
- Furniture
- Propane tanks
- Yard debris (Not dirt)
- Clothes (dry and bagged)
- Automotive batteries (no cracks or leaks)
- · Building materials (doors, windows, cabinets, etc.)
- Tires limit 5 per vehicle; no semi-truck or tractor tires.
  These limits will be enforced.

Longer wait times occur in the early morning as the event opens, but lines typically decrease throughout the day.

The City reserves the right to refer loads to the Glenwood Transfer Station.

If your load is referred to the transfer station you will need to unload it yourself; County staff will not unload it for you.

This free event is exclusively for City of Springfield residents within city limits. No businesses please. Proof of residency (driver's license) will be required.



#### The following items CANNOT be accepted:

- · Loads in enclosed vehicles, such as moving trucks
- Oversized items such as hot tubs and boats
- Household garbage
- · Fluorescent lights
- Roofing shingles
- · Chemicals
- Car parts
- Paint
- Dirt
