



Mill Street Reconstruction Project: South A to Centennial Boulevard September 2024 Update

Construction on the Mill Street Reconstruction Project is starting in September. Lane closures and detours will be in place through 2025.

The project includes:

- New concrete pavement
- Sidewalk and driveway reconstruction
- ADA compliant curb ramps
- Stormwater and wastewater improvements
- Street lighting improvements
- Traffic calming
- Addition of bike facilities

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Construction is starting soon on the Mill Street Reconstruction Project. **Beginning in early September, Mill Street will be restricted to one-way traffic between Main Street and Centennial Boulevard for much of the project. Detours will be in place for people walking, rolling, biking, and driving.**

Northbound vehicle traffic will be shifted to the west side of the street and a detour will be in place for southbound traffic to go around the work zone on adjacent streets. Parking will not be permitted on Mill Street during construction. Pedestrian crossings will be limited along Mill St. and marked with detours.

Construction will begin with wastewater and stormwater pipe installation continuing into early 2025, followed by reconstruction of sidewalks and street surface on the east side of the street. Following this will be surface work on the west side of the street.

As the project continues in 2025, traffic will then be shifted to the east side of the street for northbound traffic. **Work is scheduled to be completed by the end of 2025.** Additional updates will be sent throughout the project.
