Nomination and scoring process:

- 1. Upon arrival please take some time to look at each piece of artwork.
- 2. Using the rubric criteria, identify <a href="mailto:three">three</a> adult pieces and <a href="mailto:one">one</a> youth piece you would like to nominate. Write down the title of the work and artist's name on the scoring form. <a href="Please take a picture of both the artwork and the label if you are not attending the meeting on Thursday, Oct 3 at 12:15 pm.">pm.</a>
- 3. Next, fill out **(only the name and title)** of the three adult and one youth artist and artwork title on the forms provided. These will serve as voting forms for each commissioner for the next round.

- 4. Once each commissioner has selected artwork (3 adults and 1 youth) to nominate and has filled out the forms, the compiled forms will be redistributed so each individual commissioner has an evaluation form with each commissioner's nominations.
- 5. Each commissioner will then score each of the nominated artworks adding their scores to the evaluation sheet. To help identify the location of each artwork, each commissioner will walk the group to the selected artwork.
- 6. After all score sheets are filled out and collected they will be tallied by Thi.
