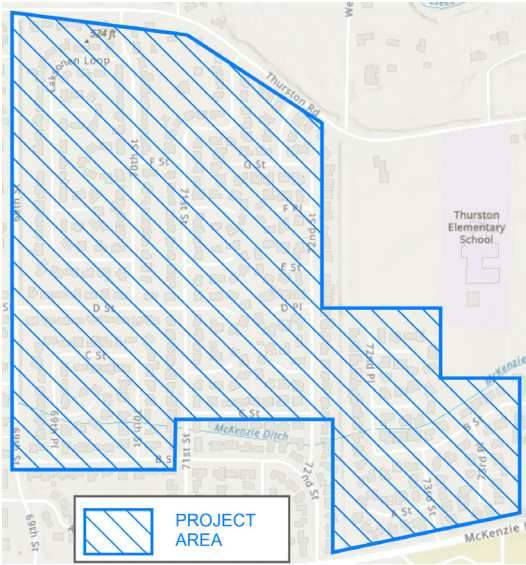

## Wastewater Pipe Rehabilitation 70th Street - 72nd Street Area

### **What does the project include?**

We're rehabilitating the main wastewater line in your neighborhood using a no-dig method called cured-in-place pipe lining. This means there's no need for excavation. The goal is to prevent rainwater and groundwater from leaking into wastewater pipes. This helps extend the useful life of the wastewater collection system owned by the City and helps reduce the amount of water sent to the Eugene-Springfield Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant.

### **When will the work happen?**

Work is expected to begin mid-March and be completed by the end of April. More details on scheduled work will be provided to residents closer to the start date.

### **Where will the project take place?**

The project area is between 69th Street & 73rd Place, and Thurston Road & Main Street. Crews will set up at maintenance access holes and move throughout the area as work progresses.

### **How will this affect me?**

There will be some noise and minor traffic delays during working hours. Wastewater service will be temporarily interrupted, residents will be notified ahead of time.

### **Is any action required of me?**

Once work moves to the wastewater pipe that serves your residence, the contractor, Insituform Technologies, will provide instructions on how to prepare for sewer service interruptions. Representatives will be on-site for questions or concerns.
