Attend In-Person

The doors at the west and south entrances to City Hall (225 5th Street, Springfield, OR, 97477) will be open to allow people to attend the meeting in person in the Library Meeting Room. METHODS FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

Citizen comments are normally scheduled under the agenda item "Business from the Audience" and are limited to three (3) minutes each. Multiple options will be provided for the public to ask questions and comment on the budget. Below are the methods which will be provided.

1.) Zoom

Zoom webinar software provides functionality for the organizer to allow attendees to speak during the meeting, provided the attendee is utilizing a computer or tablet with a microphone. During Business from the Audience, the meeting organizer will look for attendees to 'raise their hand' and will then unmute the attendees' microphone, allowing them to provide their name, ward, and submit comment or ask a question.

2.) Written comment provided by e-mail

Written comment may be received via email sent to Budget@Springfield-or.gov through 3:00 p.m. the day of the Budget Committee meeting. Written comment will be read by staff into the record if time remains during the business from the audience section of the meeting and will be given a three-minute time limit per submission. Comments received must include the name and ward of the individual providing the comment.

3.) Written comment provided by regular mail

Members of the public may send written comment by postal mail to: Finance Department, Attn: Jessica Mumme, Budget & Procurement Manager, City of Springfield, 225 Fifth Street, Springfield, Oregon 97477. Written comment will be read by staff into the record if time remains during the business from the audience section of the Budget Committee meeting and will be given a three-minute time limit per submission. Responses must list the name and Ward of the individual providing the comment. Comments by postal mail must be received at City Hall by Wednesday, May 14, 2025, prior to the start of the Budget Committee meeting to be read into the record.

4.) Attend and provide comment in person at City Hall

This is a public meeting where deliberation of the Budget Committee will take place and public comment will be heard. Any person may ask questions about and comment on the FY26 proposed budget and/or the City's use of State Shared Revenue funds at this time.
