New sidewalks and ADA-accessible ramps will be added along important school routes. These Safe Routes to School projects aim to reduce traffic and pollution, boost health, and give students a safe, comfortable way to get to school. **Construction is expected between January 2026 and August 2026.**

### Why do the project?

Several Springfield schools don't have complete sidewalk connections. Filling these gaps makes it safer and easier for students and neighbors traveling to nearby schools.

### Where will work happen?

- **Maple Elementary School**  
21st Street (west side) – L Street to Centennial Boulevard
- **Riverbend Elementary School**  
E Street (south side) – 51st Street to 52nd Street  
E Street (north side) – 51st Street to E Street cul-de-sac
- **Centennial Elementary School**  
L Street Curb Cut – Centennial Elementary School Access
